#### London Sightseeing Tour

### Highland Lochs, Glens & Whisky Tour

Stirling Castle, The Trossachs, Roby Roy country and Loch Lomond. Depart Edinburgh towards Stirling to spend the day taking in Stirling Castle and the beauty of Loch Lomond National Park.
