Barcelona City Tour

Enjoy the most emblematic sights the city has to offer. Start with a sightseeing tour that will take you up Passeig de Gracia, where you will see the most famous Gaudi houses, casa Battlo and La casa Mila as well as other majestic buildings of the Modernism era. You will continue the visit driving up Mountjuic where you will enjoy a cable card ride with beautiful views of the city.

Gaudi Barcelona Tour

The Sagrada Familia is one of the most visited buildings in the world. Visit the astonishing interior of this church, where vaults reach seventy meters. Then visit the Sagrada Familia Museum, where you will see drawings, plaster models and pictures about the history and development of this basilica. Discover Gaudi's bizarre Park Guell which has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Cooking Workshop in Barcelona

Learn about the local culture through participation in a cooking workshop with an experienced chef and enjoy a meal comprised of dishes prepared during the workshop. Menus will vary according to season and available fresh produce in local markets, but they usually consist of two different tapas, a main dish (paella) and a dessert.

Montserrat Tour

On this tour you will pass elegant squares such as Plaza de Oriente, Plaza de Espana, Parque del Oeste, Principe Pio, el Puente del Rey, la Ermita de la Virgen del Puerto, ending at Segovia Bridge - Puente de Segovia, one of the best viewpoints of the Royal Palace and the Cathedral of Almudena. Visit the Royal Palace, which was built in the XVIII century upon the ancient Baroque Italian style fortress of the Habsburg.
